

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

5.1 Conclusion

In this chapter, the writer makes a conclusion based on the data analysis from the previous chapter and added some suggestions for the next researcher who wants to conduct a study on this topic.

According to the data analysis from the previous chapter, the writer found a total of 86 data of slang languages found in Forrest Gump movie from the beginning until the end of the movie. Based on the data analysis the writer found all the types of slang based on Elisa Mattiello theory (2008). The writer found a total of 41 datum with Vulgarity and Offensiveness type of slang. 24 datum with Informality and Intimacy type of slang. 18 datum with Group-Identification and Creativity type of slang. And only 3 datum with Privacy and Secrecy type of slang. The most common type of slang from the movie is Vulgarity and Offensiveness type. This show that the movie has used a lot of vulgar and offensive word used to insult or sometimes used to speak in a casual conversation.

The writer found all the translation strategy based on Karolina Butkuvienė and Lolita Petrulionė theory (2010). The writer found a total of 42 datum with Softening strategy. 25 datum with Literal Translation strategy. And 19 datum with Stylistic Compensation strategy. This is because the movie used a lot of vulgar and offensive word. Therefore, the translator often used Softening strategy so the translation can be acceptable

for the audience so they can enjoy watching the movie without having to worry about the rude and vulgar words in the translation because sometimes it's a part of translator's job.
