CASE SUMMARY

Based on data at the Independent Midwife Practice (PMB) A Tajur Halang, Bogor Regency, in 2022 the number of ANC from K1, K2, K3 and K4 who visited was 85 people, the number who gave birth (INC) was 36 people, the number visited from KF 1, KF 2, KF 3 and KF 4 Postpartum (PNC) was 36 people and newborns visited from KN 1, KN 2, KN 3 with a total of 36 people. From these data there are no MMR and IMR deaths at PMB in 2021. The purpose is Implementing Comprehensive Midwifery Care for Mrs. T with a midwifery management approach and SOAP documentation at PMB A Tajur Halang. How is Comprehensive Midwifery Care for Mrs. P G1P0A0 Gestational Age 39 weeks at PMB A Tajur Halang During her pregnancy Mrs. T progresses physiologically even though there are complaints of third-trimester discomfort such as false contraction low back pain. These complaints can be overcome with health education. Mothers with term pregnancies (39 weeks) during stages I-IV were running normally, during stage I massage care was carried out using the acupressure massage technique. The baby was born spontaneously with a male sex, weight was 3200 grams, height was 48 cm. At the postpartum involution visit, walking normally was given lactation massage. At the neonatal visit, the baby's weight experienced an increased by 100 grams from birth weight due to baby massage which made the baby strong in suckling. It is recommended that midwives should be able to optimally implement CoMC-based midwifery care and always provide the latest evidence-based care. The author has carried out comprehensive midwifery care given to Mrs. Twith the results of the mother's complaints during pregnancy resolved, the mother gave birth at a health facility, newborns and postpartum in normal circumstances.
