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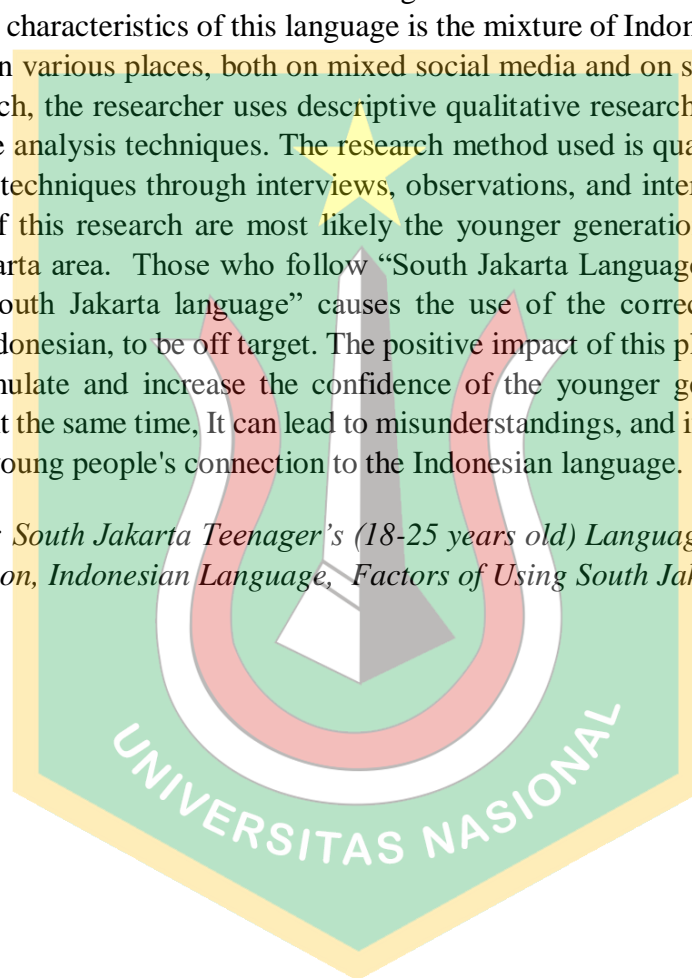
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ABSTRACT

This study aims to determine the effect of the existence of a specific mixture of Indonesian and English language used by the young people in South Jakarta, especially in the Kemang area. The researcher is very impressed with the increasing vocabulary among the young people there. This phenomenon of language mixing, popularly known as the "Jakesel language," refers to the habits of young people who often communicate with each other through a mixture of Indonesian and English. One of the characteristics of this language is the mixture of Indonesian and English in its use in various places, both on mixed social media and on some occasions. In this research, the researcher uses descriptive qualitative research methods through descriptive analysis techniques. The research method used is qualitative, with data collection techniques through interviews, observations, and internet searches. The subjects of this research are most likely the younger generation who live in the South Jakarta area. Those who follow "South Jakarta Language" follow existing trends. "South Jakarta language" causes the use of the correct mother tongue, namely Indonesian, to be off target. The positive impact of this phenomenon is that it can stimulate and increase the confidence of the younger generation to learn English. At the same time, It can lead to misunderstandings, and if it persists, it may diminish young people's connection to the Indonesian language.

ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui pengaruh adanya campuran bahasa Indonesia dan Inggris tertentu yang digunakan oleh generasi muda di Jakarta Selatan, khususnya di kawasan Kemang. Peneliti sangat terkesan dengan bertambahnya kosa kata di kalangan remaja disana. Fenomena percampuran bahasa yang populer dengan sebutan “Bahasa Jaksel” ini mengacu pada kebiasaan generasi muda yang sering berkomunikasi satu sama lain melalui campuran bahasa Indonesia dan Inggris. Salah satu ciri bahasa ini adalah adanya percampuran bahasa Indonesia dan Inggris dalam penggunaannya di berbagai tempat, baik di media sosial campuran maupun di beberapa kesempatan. Dalam penelitian ini peneliti menggunakan metode penelitian deskriptif kualitatif melalui teknik analisis deskriptif. Metode penelitian yang digunakan adalah kualitatif, dengan teknik pengumpulan data melalui wawancara, observasi, dan pencarian internet. Subjek penelitian ini adalah generasi muda yang berdomisili di wilayah Jakarta Selatan. Mereka yang mengikuti “Bahasa Jakarta Selatan” mengikuti tren yang ada. “Bahasa Jakarta Selatan” menyebabkan penggunaan bahasa ibu yang benar yaitu bahasa Indonesia tidak tepat sasaran. Dampak positif dari fenomena ini adalah dapat merangsang dan meningkatkan kepercayaan diri generasi muda untuk belajar bahasa Inggris. Pada saat yang sama, hal ini juga dapat menimbulkan pemahaman yang salah. Jika hal ini terus berlanjut maka akan melemahkan rasa memiliki generasi muda terhadap bahasa Indonesia.
