5.1 Conclusion

After finding out the figurative language and meaning in each lyric of 11 songs, from above found many figurative languages in selected Pamungkas album song lyrics and it can be seen that the song of Pamungkas uses many types of figurative languages to make the sentence more interesting. Not all types of imagery are used in the lyrics of some Pamungkas albums. I have identified four types of figurative languages used in selected lyrics from Pamungkas albums: personification, metaphor, simile and hyperbole. There are 7 personifications, 11 metaphors, 2 similes, and 5 hyperboles. The most dominant figurative language in the song lyric of the “Solipsism” album of Pamungkas is metaphor. There are? lyrics containing metaphor in the song lyric of Pamungkas. The songwriter uses figurative language to emphasize to the readers about the feeling and emotion what the writer wants to say in his life through a song. Especially on the “Solipsism” album of Pamungkas. Figurative language makes song lyrics more beautiful to listen to. Because figurative language is used the imagination on the song lyric.
