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
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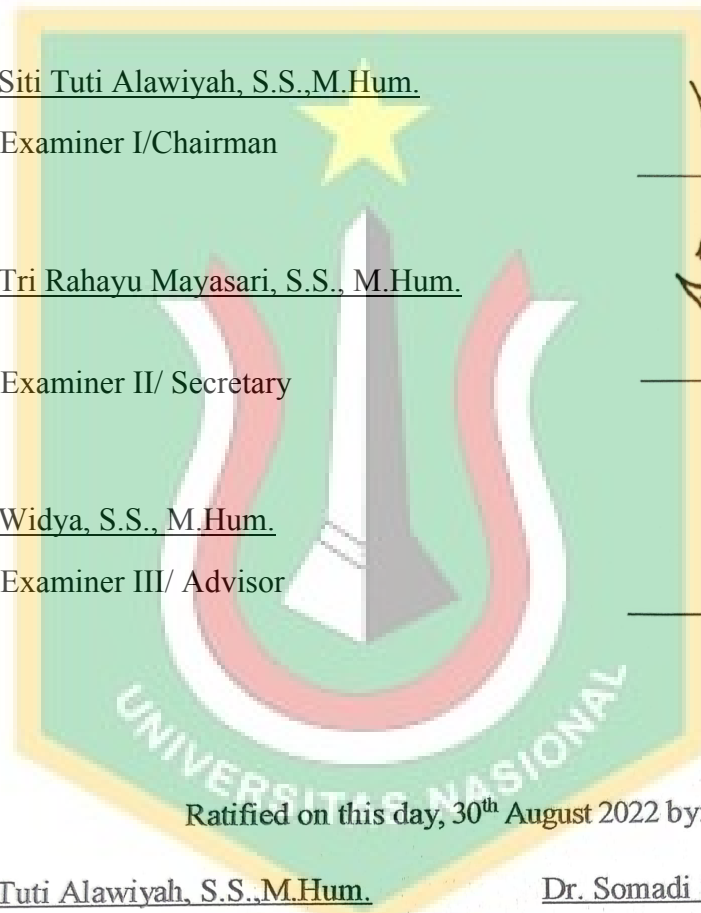
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




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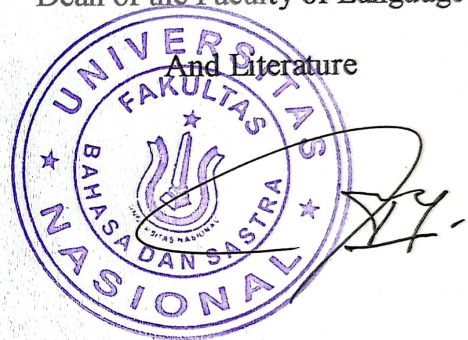
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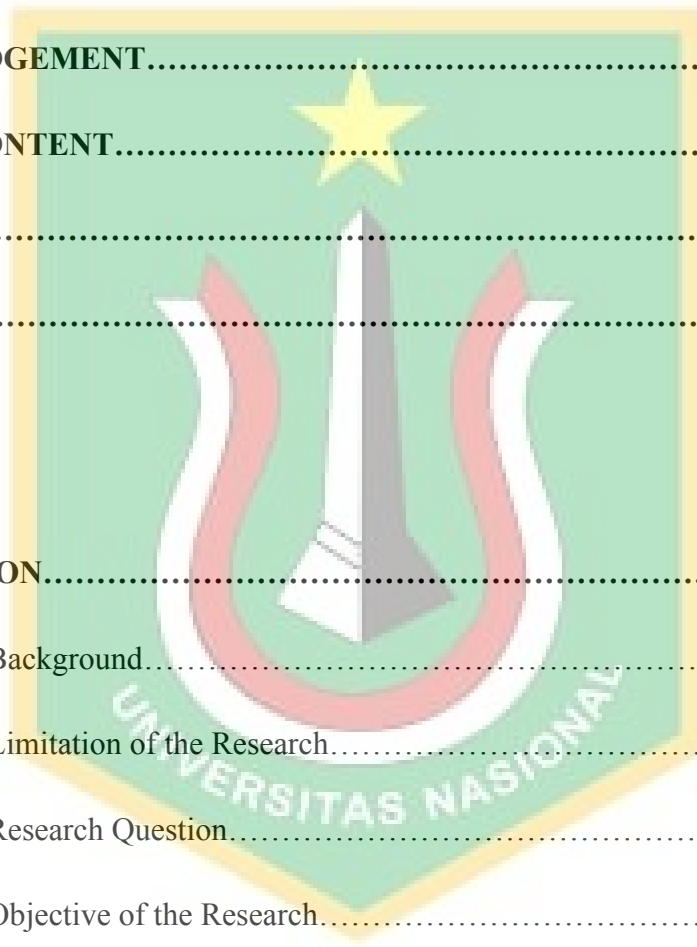
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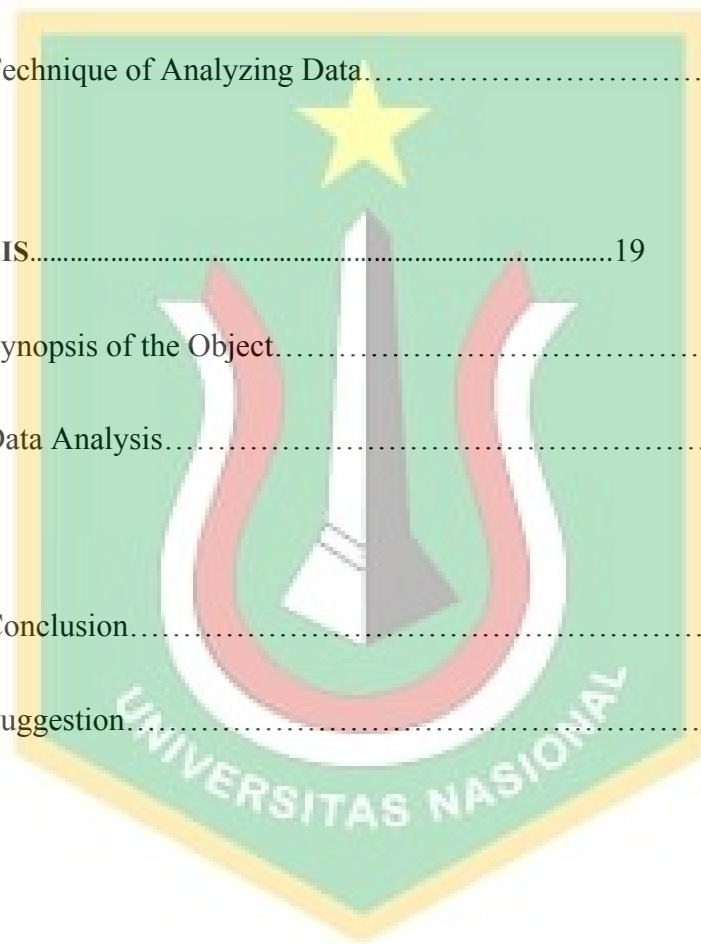
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ABSTRACT

The present study aims to determine the types of illocutionary act in the “Transcript of Queens Gambit”. The types of illocutions that Yule (1996) proposes are the focus of this research.

The research used qualitative descriptive by analyzing transcript of *the Queens Gambit* speech as the primary data. Later, the data sources in this study is collected by watching *Queens Gambit* Series on Netflix season 1 episode 1 to make it clear that speech meets the criteria in the context in which speech is spoken. Coming after, the data are analyzed and transcribed into the written form. Then, the data is divided to five groups of types of illocutionary speech acts. The findings reveal that there are four types of illocutionary speech acts used in the transcript of *Queens Gambit*. They are representative, expressive, directive and commissive. This shows that the one of illocutionary acts that are not found in the transcript are declarative. Reasonably, the preferred type of illocutionary speech act is representative. The revealed of the most and the least used of types of illocutionary speech acts from the transcript of *Queens Gambit*. There are representative (10), expressive (8), directive (9), commissive (6) and declarative (0). It can be interpreted that representative and expressive are preferred.

ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui jenis-jenis tindak ilokusi pada “Transcript *Queens Gambit*”. Jenis-jenis ilokusi yang dikemukakan Yule (1996) menjadi fokus pada penelitian ini. Deskriptif kualitatif digunakan dalam Penelitian ini dengan menganalisis transkrip *Queens Gambit* sebagai data primer. Berikutnya, sumber data pada penelitian ini dikumpulkan dengan menonton *Queens Gambit Series* di Netflix season 1 episode 1 untuk memperjelas ucapan memenuhi kriteria dalam konteks saat ucapan diucapkan. Kemudian, data dianalisis dan ditranskripsikan pada bentuk tertulis. Selanjutnya, data dibagi kelompok menjadi lima jenis tindak tutur ilokusi. Temuan mengungkapkan terdapat empat jenis tindak tutur ilokusi yang digunakan pada transkrip *Queens Gambit*. Mereka adalah perwakilan, ekspresif, direktif dan komisif. Pada jenisnya, salah satu jenis tindak ilokusi yang bersifat deklaratif tidak dapat ditemukan pada tuturan tersebut. Tampaknya, jenis tindak tutur ilokusi yang lebih diminati adalah representatif. Sedangkan jenis tindak tutur ilokusi yang paling banyak dan paling sedikit dipergunakan dari transkrip *Queens Gambit*. Mereka adalah perwakilan representatif (10), ekspresif (8), direktif (9), komisif (6) dan deklaratif (0).
