

CHAPTER V

CONSCULSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the results of the research and discussion, there are several things that can be concluded regarding the research objectives. First, there are four of the five types of illocutionary acts performed by the *Queens Gambit* Transcript. This is revealed from the results that are representative (10), expressive (8), directive (9), commissive (6), and declarative (0). Second, the most widely used type of illocutionary act is representative (10). This study only examines speech acts with a pragmatic approach. In addition to studying the meaning of speech acts in the transcript of the serial "*Queens Gambit*" with a pragmatic theoretical approach.

5.2 Suggestion

Hopefully, the current findings might assist future researchers in expanding their research into speech acts. I made an effort to analyze the speech act in terms of the various illocutionary activities. As a result, scholars from diverse backgrounds are encouraged to contribute to and advance the discourse analysis study.
