

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

#### 5.1 Conclusion

The purpose of this research is to find out who is the main female character in the film "Live-Action Mulan (2020)". In analyzing it, the researcher uses the character theory of Petrie and Dennis (2008) to reveal the main female character, namely Hua Mulan, a brave, tough, not-giving-up woman who is the focus of this film. The theory used by researchers to uncover characters is Burroway's (2000) characterization theory.

This study also reveals how the social background is depicted in the film "LiveAction (2020)". Using the setting theory from Nurgiyantoro (2009), the researcher uses a type of setting that is divided into three categories: setting of place, setting of time, and setting of the environment. From the setting theory used in this study, the researcher found a social setting that refers to beliefs or culture in the Chinese Dynasty about the value of men compared to women. Patriarchal culture in the film "LiveAction (2020)" is about patriarchal culture that is not balanced for women, as experienced by Hua Mulan from the time she was a little girl until she grew up. And the researcher also analyzes radical feminism by Kate Millet (1997), which is related to patriarchal culture. This study also reflects on patriarchal culture and the main character's struggle against the patriarchal system in the film "Live-Action Mulan (2020)". The author employs patriarchal theory when discussing

patriarchy. In Sylvia Walby's (1990) novel, the author reveals that gender inequality is experienced by Hua Mulan, who replaces her father as an imperial war soldier. The author also uses Alan Swingewood's reflection theory (1972) in his book *The Sociology of Literature* to reflect on patriarchal culture in film “Live-Action Mulan (2020).”
