

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the results of research and analysis on seven song lyrics in English and Korean songs with the theme of personal experiences and feelings of BTS members during the COVID-19 pandemic. In the previous chapter researchers found 17 metaphors with details shown in the following table:

Based on the table above, researchers classify the types of metaphors

according to Stephen Ullmann's theory, there are four types of metaphors found in the album *Be* by Bts (Bangtan Sonyeondan). The first type, namely the abstracting metaphor, is the most commonly found metaphor with 10 data, then the synesthetic metaphor 3 data, the animal metaphor 3 data, and the anthropomorphic metaphor 1 data. In this data it is seen that the most dominant type of metaphor is found inside the album *Be* Bts the metaphor of abstracting. This shows that the songs use a lot of expressions that are vague or abstract in nature. Like the previous explanation that abstracting metaphors tend to use words that aim to embellish the language in song lyrics.

This study uses MIP (Metaphor Identification Procedure) which means the procedure or method used to identify metaphors in written or spoken language and 3 metaphorical components, namely topics, vehicles, soil. Based on the results of the study, the meaning of metaphor in all the data above has a relationship with its lexical meaning, some people do not easily understand metaphors in a word or sentence. Sentences that use metaphors or figurative language some people have to read or hear them repeatedly to understand the meaning of the meaning of metaphors because they usually understand too much that metaphors can also be influenced by a person's lifestyle. The researcher concluded that if a person can understand metaphors or figurative language then he will easily understand the meaning that the author wants to convey in a song.

5.2 Suggestions

At the end of this thesis, the researcher will also give some suggestions, namely:

1. The researcher realizes that this research is far from perfect.

2. Researchers hope that this research can help students who will analyze songs on the same topic, namely about metaphors or figurative language so that they can learn more about metaphors so that they can do more specific research on metaphors. Then the thesis can be input and useful for other researchers at least for the researcher himself.
3. For readers, researchers suggest that they can take the message shown in the song from Bts' Be album and get to know the metaphor better, because it can be useful information to understand the meaning of each sentence that contains metaphors so as to improve the understanding of figurative language used by society and also those often encountered in literary works such as song lyrics.
4. Especially for English Literature students, researchers hope to learn about figurative language or metaphors and can make a much better thesis because this is the closing of the English Literature course.
