



ABSTRACT

The aim of this study to analyze the similarities in intrinsic elements between Asato Asato 86 (Eighty-Six) and George Orwell Animal Farm novels and also to examine the intrinsic elements differ between Asato Asato 86 (Eighty-Six) and George Orwell Animal Farm novels.
