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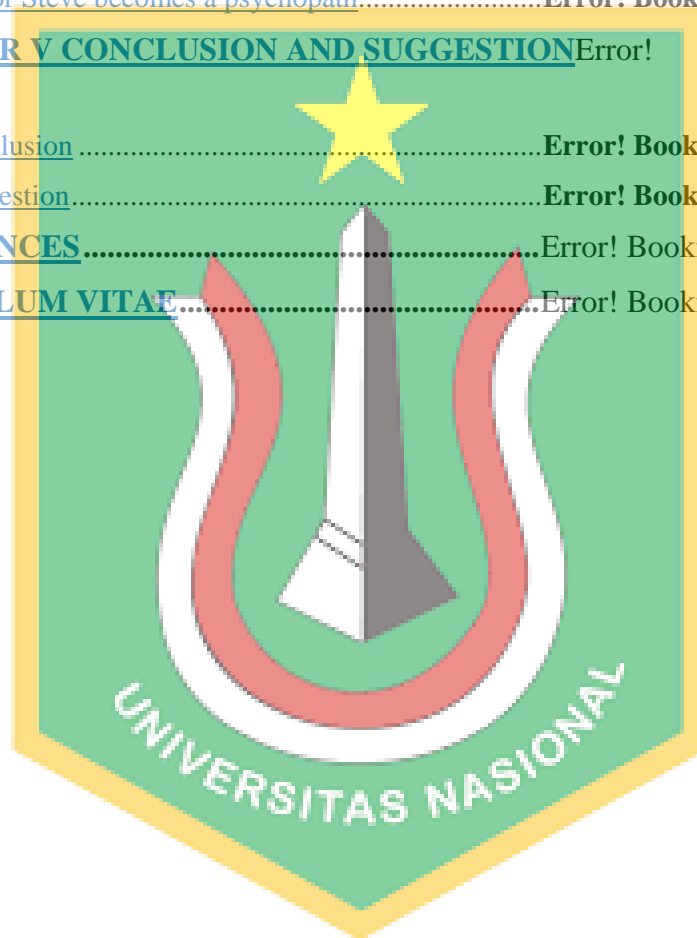
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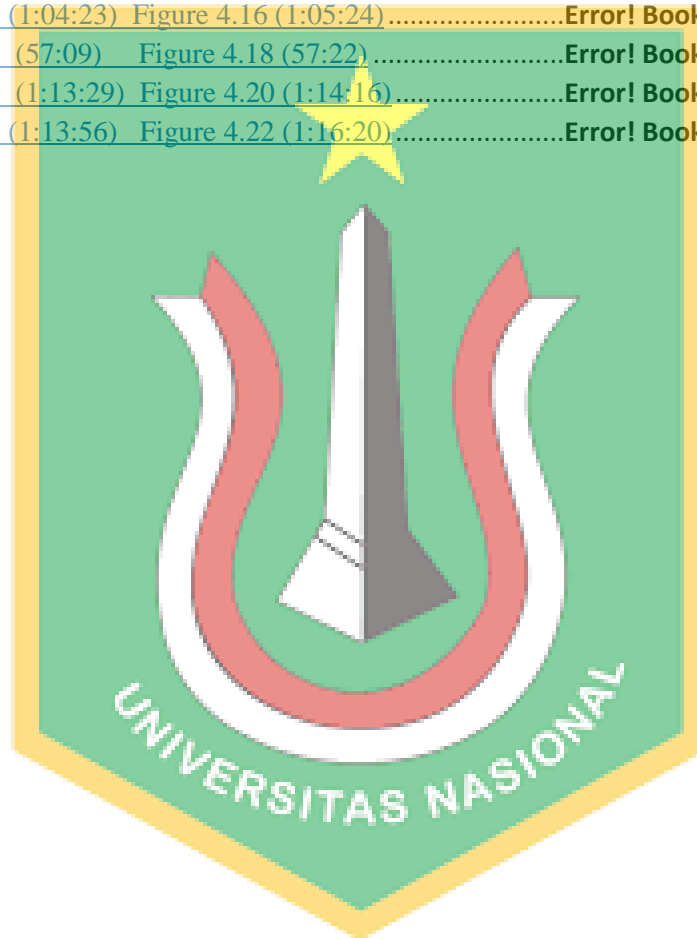
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## ABSTRAK

Skripsi ini bertujuan untuk mengamati gejala psikopat pada tokoh utama melalui pendekatan psikologis abnormal dalam *Fresh*, film bergenre thriller komedi. Dengan menggunakan metode kualitatif dan teknik deskriptif, penelitian ini mendeskripsikan karakter Brendan Steven Kemp melalui teori ciri-ciri psikopat dari Robert D. Hare, melalui lensa teori psikoanalisis Freud tentang Id, Ego, dan Superego yang berlandaskan pada teori Psikoanalisis Sigmund Freud. Berdasarkan temuan penelitian, peneliti mengidentifikasi lima ciri psikopat yang ditampilkan oleh Steve sebagai tokoh utama dalam film tersebut. Ciri-ciri ini termasuk menjadi Fasih dan Dangkal, menunjukkan Kurangnya penyesalan atau rasa bersalah, menunjukkan Kurangnya empati, Penipu dan manipulatif, dan menunjukkan emosi yang dangkal. Hasil penelitian mengungkapkan bahwa karakter Steve menjadi psikopat dalam film tersebut karena egonya yang terlalu dipengaruhi oleh id, mengakibatkan melemahnya kemampuan superego untuk mengatur id. Ketidakseimbangan ini menyebabkan ego Steve yang lemah tidak mampu untuk menjaga keharmonisan antara tuntutan id dan realitas nilai moral. Akibatnya, Steve terkena kelainan yang berhubungan dengan psikopat.

## ABSTRACT

This thesis aims to observe the symptoms of psychopathy in the main character through an abnormal psychological approach in *Fresh*, a film with the comedy thriller genre. By using qualitative methods and descriptive techniques, this study describes the character of Brendan Steven Kemp through psychopathic characteristics using Robert D. Hare's theory, through the lens of Freud's psychoanalytic theory of the Id, Ego, and Superego, grounded in Sigmund Freud's Psychoanalysis theory. Based on the research findings, the researcher identifies five psychopathic characteristics displayed by Steve as the main character in the film. These traits include being Glib and Superficial, showing a Lack of remorse or guilt, demonstrating a Lack of empathy, being Deceitful and manipulative, and exhibiting Shallow emotions. The research reveals that Steve's character becomes a psychopath in the movie due to his ego being excessively influenced by the id, resulting in a weakened superego's ability to regulate the id. This imbalance causes Steve's weak ego to struggle in maintaining harmony between the demands of the id and the realities of moral values. Consequently, Steve develops a disorder associated with psychopathy.
