

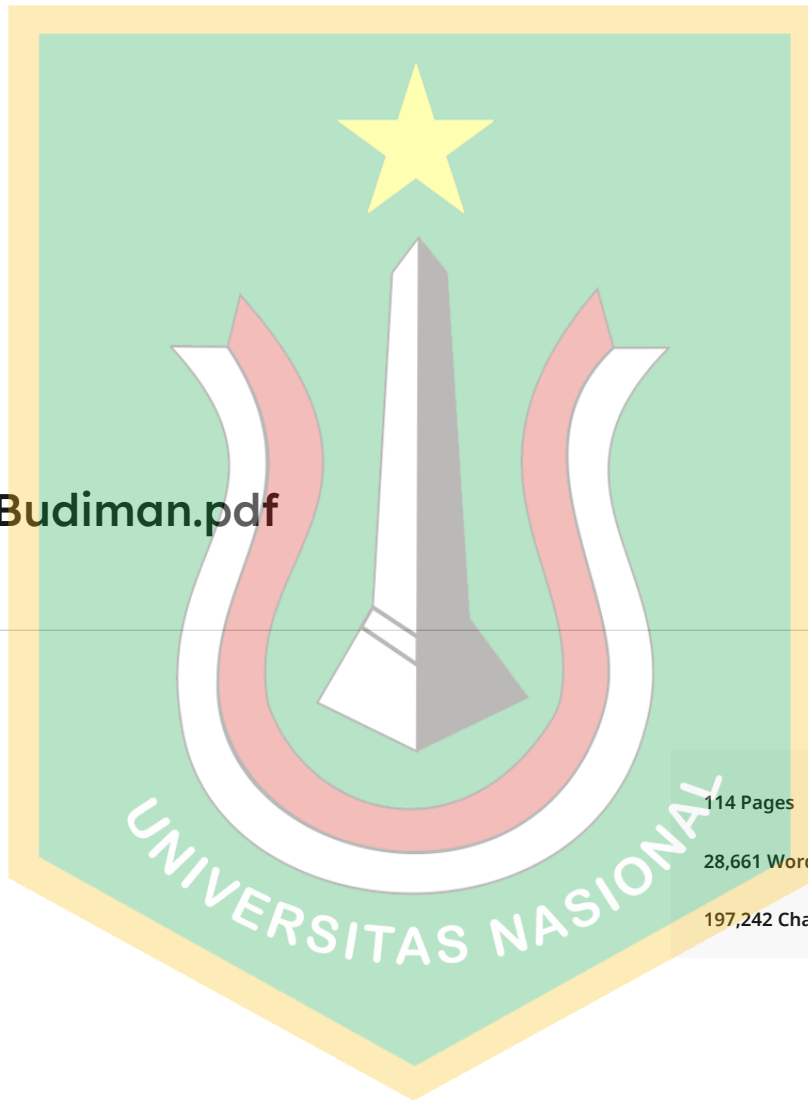

A Flag is not necessarily an indicator of a problem. However, we'd recommend you focus your attention there for further review.
